

Human Rights Day - Self-determination / Menseregte Dag - Selfbeskikking



Dear Supporter,

Today, South Africa celebrates Human Rights. The Cape Independence Party - CAPEXIT asserts that for the Western Cape people, no right is more essential than their God-given right to Self-determination. This basic human right is a founding principle of democracy, and affirms all peoples freedom and choice to shape their political, cultural, and economic destiny.

This right is guaranteed in International Law, the UN Charter, African Charter, as well as in the South African Constitution, and it safeguards all people's right to live according to their traditions, values, and beliefs, free from external or political interference or any form of oppression.

The right to self-determination applies unequivocally to the Cape, and our people.

With our distinct almost 400 year history, rich heritage, and Kaapse kultuur, self-determination for the Western Cape would mean cutting the chains binding us to the ANC and EFF, granting us greater autonomy, and if we so choose, full sovereignty and independence.

Exercising this right will ensure the return of justice, peace and prosperity, and will be the democratic expression of our people's will. It will empower us to choose a governance system that secures our safety, delivers quality education, creates abundant employment opportunities, and upholds all other fundamental human rights and personal freedoms.

Similarly, the relationships that the Cape Independence Party has built internationally over the last few years, in particular within the United States, is based upon a shared belief in these human rights and a common value system premised on the right to self-determination.

The Cape Independence Party's relationships with its allies in the US has never been stronger than it is today, and without needing to go into too much detail, over the last few weeks our interactions and relationships within the US have grown from strength to strength.

Our partners on that side share our beliefs in human rights, as well the right to self-determination, and they have expressed a willingness and determination to support us in our cause.

In the coming weeks the Cape Independence Party intends to further strengthen those relationships, travel to the United States for in-person engagements, and to expand those relationships even further. In light of the tremendous successes of Afriforum and Solidarity, we intend to build upon a growing international awareness of the injustices, persecution and discrimination inflicted upon the Cape by the ANC and the South African government, and to remedy these injustices through the peaceful and legal pursuit of our democratic right to self-determination.

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Vandag vier Suid-Afrika Menseregte. Die Kaapse Onafhanklikheids Party - CAPEXIT verklaar dat vir die Wes-Kapenaars geen reg meer noodsaaklik is as hul Godegewe reg op Selfbeskikking nie. Hierdie basiese mensereg is 'n grondbeginsel van demokrasie, en bevestig alle mense se vryheid en keuse om hul politieke, kulturele en ekonomiese lot te vorm.

Hierdie reg word gewaarborg in die Internasionale Reg, die VN-handves, Afrika-handves, sowel as in die Suid-Afrikaanse Grondwet, en dit beskerm alle mense se reg om volgens hul tradisies, waardes en oortuigings te lewe, vry van eksterne of politieke inmenging of enige vorm van onderdrukking.

Die reg op selfbeskikking geld onomwonde vir die Kaap, en ons mense.

Met ons kenmerkende byna 400 jaar geskiedenis, ryk erfenis en Kaapse kultuur, sou selfbeskikking vir die Wes-Kaap beteken dat ons die kettings wat ons aan die ANC en EFF bind, sal af sny om ons groter outonomie, en as ons so verkies, volle soewereiniteit en onafhanklikheid te verleen.

Die uitoefening van hierdie reg sal die terugkeer van geregtigheid, vrede en voorspoed verseker, en sal die demokratiese uitdrukking van ons mense se wil wees. Dit sal ons bemagtig om 'n regeringstelsel te kies wat ons veiligheid verseker, kwaliteit onderwys lewer, oorvloedige werksgeleenthede skep en alle ander fundamentele menseregte en persoonlike vryhede handhaaf.

Net so is die verhoudings wat die Kaapse Onafhanklikheids Party oor die afgelope paar jaar internasionaal gebou het, veral binne die Verenigde State, gebaseer op 'n gedeelde geloof in hierdie menseregte en 'n gemeenskaplike waardestelsel wat op die reg op selfbeskikking gegrond is.

In die lig van die geweldige suksesse van Afriforum en Solidariteit, beoog ons om voort te bou op 'n groeiende internasionale bewustheid van die ongeregtighede, vervolging en diskriminasie wat die Kaap deur die ANC en die Suid-Afrikaanse regering aangedoen word, en om hierdie ongeregtighede reg te stel deur die vreedsame en wettige strewe na ons demokratiese reg op selfbeskikking.
