Dear Supporter,

The Cape Independence Party - CAPEXIT is calling on all home owners and concerned citizens and taxpayers of the City of Cape Town, to sign a petition to formally object to the draft budget for the 2025–2026 financial year and to submit comments directly to the City as well. The deadline for submitting comments is Friday 2 May.

The concerns regarding the proposed budget include unrealistically high rate increases, water, electricity and cleaning levies and a possible breach of the Municipal Act. The rate increases may potentially result in middle-income residents having to face the reality of being unable to afford their homes any longer and forced to find an alternative place of residence.

We urge all concerned to make use of this opportunity to apply pressure on the City to revise the draft budget and find alternative sources of funding rather than over-burdened taxpayers.
